Going out *on* the streets to get people *off* the streets and back into the mainstream....

The organization's mission is to provide health-related services, education, and advocacy to reduce the incidence and burdens of homelessness in Maryland.

Harkins Builders will be our guide for a hard hat tour of the soon-to-be completed clinic and headquarters for this non-profit. The 56,000 square foot project is housed within three stories, and is designed by architects KANN Partners. Sustainable features include a high percentage of recycled and regional materials, low-VOC finishes, as well as a roof comprised of 40% vegetated and 60% highly-reflective; the goal is LEED NC Gold.

Pre-registration will be limited to 25 because the tour is within an active construction site and safety is a priority. Snacks and drinks will be provided at the start of the tour.
