



3rd Annual LEED Building Tour: *Oak Bend Office Center*

This year's LEED Building Tour will feature the Oak Bend Office Center, which is seeking LEED certification. At 18,000 square feet, the Oak Bend Office Center is the soon-to-be headquarters of Wind Engineering. Several tenants have also reserved a portion of this green office space, and there's still 6,000 square feet available for lease.

Features of the building include the preservation of multiple large trees; a green roof; daylighting via clerestory windows and skylights; and on-site stormwater management. Additionally, the building shares parking with the adjacent condominium development and with Trailnet (for nearby Grant's Trail). Many other green building techniques have been employed, so be sure to join us for the tour!
